Job Purpose: To install, troubleshoot, repair and maintain production and facility equipment according to safety, predictive and productive maintenance systems and processes and schedules to support the company's business goals and objectives.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Installs and maintains production machines and the plant facility's equipment.
- 2. Provides emergency/unscheduled repairs of production equipment during production and performs scheduled maintenance repairs of production equipment during machine service.
- 3. Maintains mechanic skills including, but not limited to, mechanical, electrical, pneumatic, hydraulic, troubleshooting and repair of production machines.
- 4. Reads and interprets equipment manuals and work orders to perform required maintenance and service.
- 5. Diagnoses problems, replaces or repairs parts. Tests and adjusts, as needed.
- 6. Performs regular preventive maintenance on machines, equipment, and plant facilities.
- 7. Performs a variety of plumbing maintenance and carpentry functions.
- 8. Uses a variety of hand and power tools, electric meters, and material handling equipment in performing duties.
- 9. Detects faulty operations or defective materials. Report those and any unusual situations to supervision.
- 10. Complies with all company and OSHA safety regulations, including but not limited to the proper use of personal protective equipment, confined space, fall protection, lockout/tagout, and electrical standards.
- 11. Maintains clean and orderly work areas.

Additional Responsibilities:

- 1. Performs safety audits as assigned. Assists with training on safety standards.
- 2. May assist in the operation of machinery.
- 3. Ancillary duties as assigned.
